

12 Medals Won at Canadian Youth Long Track Championships

What an incredible month for speed skaters!

It's been a busy month for our speed skaters who have been skating all over the country and across the world.

In Fort St. John, Manitoban speed skaters brought home 12 medals from the 2023 Canadian Youth Long Track Championships.

Mia Tétrault, skating out of Eastman Speed Skating Club, earned a total of five medals, four golds and two silvers. Tétrault's first place finishes were in the 500m, 300m Mass Start, 7 Lap Mass Start and 1500m Mass Start Super Final. Her second-place finish was in the 1000m Super Final.

Tétrault was joined by Justin Cheng of Winnipeg Central Speed Skating Club who brought home four medals with one gold in the Team Pursuit, one silver in the 500m, and two bronze in the 7 Lap Mass Start and 1500m Super Final Mass Start.

Willa Dowse, also of Eastman Speed Skating Club, had a first-place finish in the 1000m Super Final, a second-place finish in Team Pursuit, and a third-place finish in the 7 Lap Mass Start.

Congratulations to these skaters and all who participated at the LT Championships!

Canada Cup 3 was also a great experience despite some freezing cold weather which resulted in the cancellation of Day 2. Erik Kulbacki and Kai Peacock skated beautiful in both the Neo Junior Male 1000m and 3000m with Erik getting silver in the 1000m and bronze in the 3000m, and Kai skating to first place in the 3000m and third in the 1000m. Olivia Krawchuk skated to gold in the Neo Junior Female 1000m. Congratulations to all our skaters and a big thanks to our volunteers for pulling off an amazing event. It was wonderful to host and show our hospitality to people from outside our province.
