# Speed Skating Manitoba is excited to announce a total potential prize pool of +\$18,500 for competitors participating in The Maple Leaf Construction 2024 Western Canadian Outdoor Classic.

There will be three prize money age categories per distance and gender: Open (M/F - all skaters), U19 (M/F - A2 & Younger), U16 (M/F- B1 & Younger). There will be an additional prize money category for 'Friday Night Lights' which will be 100m sprints in hockey skates.

Competitors should note that they can only win one cash prize per distance. For example, if a U19 skater finishes first in the 500m event, they will win the Open category but will not receive the prize money for the U19 category. In such a case, the prize money for the U19 category will be awarded to the next eligible U19 skaters. This means that the second, third, and fourth place Juniors in the U19 category will receive the U19 prize money if they do not also finish on the Open podium. All recipients of prize money must be Members in good standing with the Provincial/Territorial organization as well as SSC. For international athletes they must be members in good standing with their national organization. Please note that there will be no age advancements granted for this event to remain aligned with SSC athlete pathways and safety guidelines. Event Distances: 500m, 1000m, 1500m, 3000m F/5000m M

Aside from prize money, medals will be presented to all age divisions as presented in the event bulletin at the Bieber Wealth Management podium. The following age categories will award a gold, silver and bronze medal: Special O Mixed Gender, Fundamentals mixed gender, LT2 mixed gender, Youth Male, Youth Female, Neo-Junior Female, Neo-Junior Male, Junior Female, Junior Male, Senior Female, Senior Male, Masters Female 1, 2, and 3, and Masters Male 1, 2, and 3.

Red River Speed has generously sponsored the FUNdamentals and Youth categories and gift cards will be provided to podium finishers for all distance. Special Olympics Manitoba (SOM) has sponsored the Special Olympics category and SOM swag will be provided to all podium finishers.

In the event of a tie the money will be split accordingly.

The competition will consist of one round of 100m races, in which all registrants will compete in a heat, with 3 competitors on the line. Heats will be seeded based on age. Upon completion, all heat times will be collated, and the top three Males and top three Females will earn a spot in the final, which will consist of the fastest three times in each division. All competitors must wear hockey skates.

The finals will determine the order of the first, second, and third place prize money.

In the event of a tie the money will be split accordingly.

Restrictions: Skaters born on or after July 1st, 2007, who participate in any of the mentioned distances, are eligible for the corresponding prize money, except if they have already earned more money in a different age category. This means that skaters cannot receive multiple cash prizes for the same distance. It's important to highlight that Youth and L2T skaters will be competing in the 500m Olympic-style race as part of their racing schedule and will therefore be eligible for the cash prize pools mentioned above for that distance.



## U19 FEMALE & MALE (A2 SKATERS & YOUNGER)



## FOR EACH DISTANCE: 500M, 1000M, 1500M, AND 3000M F/ 5000M M

#### \$300 awarded for Gold

### \$150 awarded for Silver

#### \$75 awarded for Bronze

In the event of a tie the money will be split accordingly.

Restrictions: Skaters born on or after July 1st, 2004, who participate in any of the mentioned distances, are eligible for the respective prize money, with the exception of those who have already earned more money in a different age category. This means that skaters cannot receive multiple cash prizes for the same distance. For example, if a U16 skater wins the 500m U16 Category and also secures the second place in the 500m U19 category, they will be awarded the U19 prize, which offers a higher amount of money, and the U16 prizes will be given to the next U16 placements.



## OPEN FEMALE & MALE



## FOR EACH DISTANCE: 500M, 1000M, 1500M, AND 3000M F / 5000M M

#### \$700 awarded for Gold

### \$350 awarded for Silver

#### \$175 awarded for Bronze

In the event of a tie the money will be split accordingly.

The open category prizes are available to all participants regardless of age.

Restrictions: Male skaters participating in any of the mentioned distances can qualify for the prize money associated with that distance, except for those who have already earned more money in a different age category. This means that a skater cannot win multiple cash prizes for the same distance. For example, if a U19 skater wins the 500m U19 Category and also secures the second place in the 500m Senior Open category, they will receive the Senior Open prize, which offers a higher amount of money, and the U19 prizes will be awarded to the next U19 placements.
